09:00 Arrive at the Naval Aviation Museum

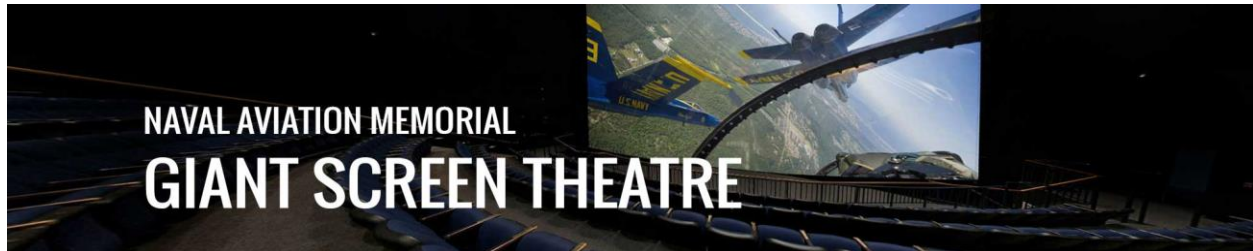

***In order to align NAS Pensacola with security directives issued by the Secretary of the Navy, the air station commanding officer has directed that beginning February 1, 2016, all visitors to the National Naval Aviation Museum, Fort Barrancas and Pensacola Lighthouse who do not possess a Department of Defense identification card or are unescorted by the holder of a Department of Defense identification card, will be required to enter the installation via the West Gate located off Blue Angel Parkway. Directions listed below:
DIRECTIONS TO THE NATIONAL NAVAL AVIATION MUSEUM USING THE WEST (BACK) GATE.***

1. COMING FROM INTERSTATE **I-10** EAST OR WEST: TAKE EXIT **7A** GOING SOUTH ON PINE FOREST ROAD / COUNTY HWY- **297** FOR 2.30 MILES.
2. TURN RIGHT ONTO **NORTH BLUE ANGEL PARKWAY / FL-173**. CONTINUE TO FOLLOW **FL-173** FOR 15.97 MILES. THIS HWY WILL TAKE YOU STRAIGHT INTO THE WEST (BACK) GATE OF PENSACOLA NAVAL AIR STATION. GATE ACCESS IS REQUIRED.
3. ONCE THROUGH THE WEST (BACK) GATE PROCEED ON (NOW RADFORD ROAD), FOR 3.11 MILES. THE MUSEUM WILL BE ON THE LEFT.

DIRECTIONS TO THE NATIONAL NAVAL AVIATION MUSEUM COMING FROM THE EAST ON HWY. 98. (PENSACOLA BEACH, GULF BREEZE, NAVARRE, FORT WALTON BEACH, DESTIN).

1. CONTINUE TO FOLLOW **US-98** WEST.
2. AFTER CROSSING THE PENSACOLA BAY BRIDGE, TURN SLIGHTLY LEFT ONTO BAYFRONT PARKWAY, FOR 1.17 MILES.
3. BAYFRONT PARKWAY BECOMES EAST MAIN STREET. CONTINUE FOR ANOTHER 1.75 MILES.
4. TURN A SLIGHT LEFT ONTO BARRANCAS AVENUE FOR 2.87 MILES. STAY STRAIGHT ONTO **FL-292 /BARRANCAS AVENUE**. AT THE CORNER OF NAVY BOULEVARD, (**HWY 295**) AND GULF BEACH HWY, (**HWY 292**) STAY STRAIGHT ON **HWY 292** FOR 5.4 MILES.
5. TURN LEFT ON BLUE ANGEL PARKWAY / **FL-173**. CONTINUE ON **FL-173** FOR 3.1 MILES TO THE WEST (BACK) GATE OF NAVAL AIR STATION PENSACOLA. GATE ACCESS IS REQUIRED.
6. ONCE THROUGH THE WEST (BACK) GATE PROCEED ON (NOW RADFORD ROAD), FOR 3.1 MILES. THE MUSEUM WILL BE ON THE LEFT.
