Opened in 1996, the Cubi Bar Café is not only a restaurant, but a popular Museum exhibit! The Cafe's decor and layout duplicates the bar area of the famous Cubi Point Officers' Club that was a major source of enjoyment for Navy and Marine Corps squadrons, ships and units as they passed into the Western Pacific.

The Cubi Bar Cafe West Pac room will seat up 41 people comfortably for lunch and a reception of 71 people standing. Or you can reserve the South Wing Patio for a smaller group overlooking our exhibits and aircraft on display.

Travel Directions

... to the National Naval Aviation Museum coming from I-10 East or West:

- 1. Take exit 7A going south on Pine Forest Road / County Hwy-297 for 2.3 miles.*
- 2. Turn right onto North Blue Angel Parkway / FL-173 and follow for 15.97 miles. This takes you straight into the West Gate of Pensacola Naval Air Station. Gate access is required.*
- 3. Once through the gate, travel straight ahead. Follow it for 3.1miles to the museum on the left.*

... to the Museum coming from the east on Highway 98 (Pensacola Beach, Gulf Breeze, Navarre, Ft. Walton Beach, Destin):

- 1. Follow US-98 West toward Pensacola across the Bay Bridge.*
- 2. Stay left on Bayfront Parkway, which becomes E. Main St. Continue for 2.9 miles.*
- 3. Make a left onto Barrancas Ave./FL-292 and continue for 2.87 miles.*
- 4. At the intersection with S. Navy Blvd, the name changes to Gulf Beach Hwy. (still FL-292). Continue west on Gulf Beach Hwy. 5.2 miles to Blue Angel Parkway. Along the way, name changes to Sorrento Rd.*
- 5. Turn left onto Blue Angel Parkway and travel 3.5 miles to the Back Gate of the Naval Air Station.*
- 6. Once through the gate, travel straight ahead. . Follow it for 3.1miles to the museum on the left.*

From the West in Gulf Shores/Orange Beach,

AL 1. Head west on Perdido Beach

Boulevard-AL-182

2. At Florida state line it becomes Perdido Key Drive-FL292, travel 7

miles 3. Right on Gulf Beach Highway / FL-292A, 5 miles

4. Right on South Blue Angel Parkway straight to West Gate

5. Once through the gate, travel straight ahead. . Follow it for 31 miles to the museum on the left.
